

Bologna is home to a unique three-in-one event: the Bologna Children's Book Fair (BCBF), the world's leading trade fair for the children's publishing industry; BolognaBookPlus (BBPlus), the extension dedicated to general trade publishing; and the Bologna Licensing Trade Fair/Kids (BLTF/Kids), the BCBF licensing event for subsidiary rights of brands and properties for children, teens and young adults.

From April 13-16, 2026, these three dynamic events will run concurrently, transforming Bologna into a leading global hub for copyright exchange across publishing, multimedia, licensing, illustration, and animation. The 2026 Guest of Honour will be Norway, bringing a dedicated programme of exhibitions and workshops both at the fair and around the city.

But travelling is also part of BCBF's international DNA! In 2025, the fair embarks on its fifth Grand Tour, bringing Bologna to eight prestigious venues around the world to connect with the global publishing community. As part of its Grand Tour, Bologna presents an impressive programme of initiatives, with the participation of prominent international guests. The Tour also provides a unique opportunity to showcase the excellence of Italian publishing and the great value of Made in Italy on the global stage.

Launched in 2021 with the support of the Italian Trade Agency and the Italian Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International **Cooperation**, the initiative continues to strengthen BCBF's international presence and outreach.

Following its preview at Gamescom in Cologne, this year's Grand Tour officially kicks off at Cartoon Forum in Toulouse, before continuing on to Frankfurt, Shanghai, Guadalajara, Nuremberg, Angoulême, and New York.

In February 2026, BCBF will bring to New York an exhibition showcasing 180 international children's titles focused on the SDGs, with a special section dedicated to outstanding Italian

publishing on the theme.
