



BOLOGNA CHILDREN'S BOOK FAIR REACHES THE APPLE APP STORE TOP BOLOGNARAGAZZI DIGITAL AWARD WINNERS RELAUNCHED ON APPLE'S ONLINE PLATFORM

Inaugurated just two years ago as a prize for the most innovative digital production among book-derived "apps", the **BolognaRagazziDigital Award** has been a resounding success. This year's winning Apps and special mentions from among the 258 entries from 37 countries for a total of 137 publishers can already be downloaded from the Apple iTunes store. Next week the award-winners will be among the Apps recommended by the prestigious Apple digital platform. This marks a major success for the best inventions selected by the jury at BolognaFiere's Children's Book Fair. The Apps can be downloaded free of charge or in some cases at a cost of between 2.99 and 4.99 Euro.

The prize is divided into two categories (Fiction and Non-Fiction) and is awarded by an international Jury chaired by Warren Buckleitner (Children's Tech Revue, USA) and jury members Cristina Mussinelli, Chris Meade and Klaas Verplanke.
