AWARD CEREMONY OF THE SEVENTH EDITION

OF PREMIO STREGA RAGAZZE E RAGAZZI

Rome, 7 December 2022. Lisa Lundmark, Nadia Terranova, Mara Cerri and Francesco D'Adamo are the winners of the seventh edition of the Premio Strega Ragazze e Ragazzi. The announcement of the winners and award ceremony, offered by Strega Alberti Benevento, took place this afternoon at Più Libri Più Liberi, the trade show dedicated to small and medium-sized publishers.

Lisa Lundmark with Jenny lo squalo, illustrated by Charlotte Ramel (La Nuova Frontiera Junior) for the 6+ category, i.e., readers aged 6 and 7, received 9 votes out of the total 11 (the illustrator collected the prize); Nadia Terranova and Mara Cerri with Il segreto (Mondadori Ragazzi) for the 8+ category, readers from 8 to 10 years, with 14 votes out of 33, and Francesco D'Adamo with Giuditta e l'orecchio del diavolo (Giunti Editore) for the 11+ category, readers aged 11 to 13, with 325 votes out a total 778, were the books receiving most votes among reader from the 153 plus schools, reading groups and libraries making up the jury in Italy and abroad (Munich, Offenbach am Main, Paris, Saint-Germain-en-Laye,

The translation prize, offered by **BolognaFiere**, was awarded to **Lucia Barni** for her book *Jenny*

During the award ceremony, hosted by the writer and former winner of the Premio Strega Ragazze e Ragazzi, Alessandro Barbaglia, the finalist authors, illustrators and translators were joined by Fabio Del Giudice (Director of the Italian Publishers' Association), Giovanni Solimine (President of the Maria and Goffredo Bellonci Foundation), Angelo Piero Cappello (Director of the Centre for Books and Reading), Alberto Foschini (Past President of Strega Alberti Benevento and member of the Premio Strega Management Committee), Elena Pasoli (Exhibition Manager of the Bologna Children's Book Fair-BolognaFiere) and Simone Maci (Director, Centre West Region, BPER Banca).

For the second year running, the ceremony took place in the auditorium of the La Nuvola Congress Centre, attended by some 1,200 pupils, members of the juries from all over over Italy, namely Rivalta di Torino, Verbania, Piacenza, San Benedetto del Tronto, Florence, Rome and the surrounding area, Frosinone, Caserta, Potenza, Cosenza, Bari, and Lecce. It was a great success for an event that since its first edition has aimed to involve an increasing number of young readers.

During the meeting, Alessandro Barbaglia reminded the audience that two Strega Ragazze e Ragazzi 2022 Prizes had already been awarded: for the Best Debut book category, Miss Dicembre e il Clan di Luna by Antonia Murgo (Bompiani) and for the Best Picture Book category, Il Viaggio by Peter Van den Ende (Terre di mezzo). The winners of these two competition categories were chosen by the members of the Scientific Committee, chaired by Giovanni Solimine and made up of Marco Bartolomucci, Laura Bellacicco, Flavia Cristiano, Fabio Geda, Grazia Gotti, Maria Greco, Martino Negri, Elena Pasoli, Ilaria Tagliaferri, and Viriginia Tonfoni. The Committee also selects the finalist books in the 6+, 8+ and 11+ categories.

BPER Banca again this year awarded special prizes as part of the "La Banca che sa leggere" project, aimed to stimulate critical judgement and hence cultural growth among the younger generations. BPER awarded cash prizes for the best reading activities to the Scuola Città Pestalozzi of the Istituto Comprensivo Centro Storico Pestalozzi in Florence (6+ Category) and to the Scuola Primaria Europa Unita of the Istituto Comprensivo Tetti Francesi in Rivalta di Torino (8+ Category). The prize for the best critical review was awarded jointly to Daniel Dario lafrate of the Istituto Comprensivo, via Padre Semeria, Rome and Matilde Matone of the Istituto Comprensivo Giovanni Falcone, Grottaferrata (11+ Category).

Thanks to the renewed collaboration with IBS.it La Feltrinelli, the Award's technical sponsor, each of the approximately 2000 young jurors received a 5-euro voucher towards the purchase of the books selected, while the schools involved received a copy of the finalist books to add to their school library.
